## Financial Update

I'm so pleased to tell you that we're closer than ever to reaching our goal to see this ministry fully funded. Last year at this time, I was projecting that we needed another \$9,000/year (\$750/mo.) to come in so that the ministry would be fully funded. This year, I'm so thankful to be reporting that the number is down to \$6,000/year (\$500/mo.), and that's after my budget has increased by about \$1500 for the '04-'05 school year. Thank you for the ways that you have been active in helping to achieve our goal this year!! This ministry could not go on without your generous partnership.

## Some Creative Ideas to Help Get Me Fully Funded

Sometimes we need a little bit of help thinking outside the box. There's are lots of ways that you can help me to raise this last \$6,000 (\$500/mo.). Here are some ideas:

### Some Added Notes About Giving...

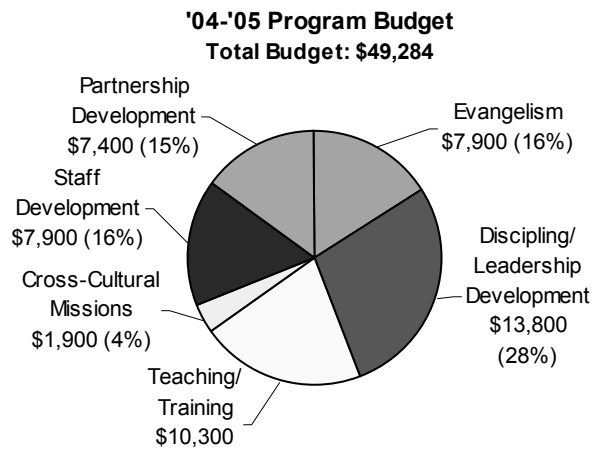
If you're **someone who traditionally gives once or twice a year**, would you consider an end-of-the-year gift to help me close in the black?

## My Budget

Below is my budget for the 2004-2005 fiscal year. It's broken up based on how I spend my time on staff. It has increased by about \$1,500 from last year's budget of \$47,733.

## Please Pray

Pray for **Basileia**, that the students we serve would have space to hear from God, that they'd grow deeply in their relationships with Him, and that they'd have renewed vision and passion for His work on campus.

Pray for our trip to **Guatemala**, that God would bring in the necessary funds (particularly for the students, but also for me), and that He'd be preparing our hearts to serve Him and His people as we're there.

Pray for my **funding**, that we'd see \$6,000 in new support come in, even before students return in September.

Pray for **Jeremy and me**, as we're in the process of buying a house. Pray that the process goes smoothly, and that we end up exactly where God wants us to be. Pray for our new neighbors, and that we'll be able to make an impact on the community around us. (I will update you all when the change of address happens!)

## A Suggested Plan

According to the chart below, 48 donors giving at the "hoped for" levels would raise \$49,200, which would meet my yearly budget. This chart is intended to suggest one option for how we might meet the budget for next year. Many combinations of the numbers below would get us there. Would you consider giving regularly to meet the needs of this ministry?

Donation Level	# of Donors hoped for at this level to reach full budget	Actual # of Donors who give at (or above) this level
1. \$400/mo. (\$4,800/yr.)	2	0
2. \$200/mo. (\$2,400/yr.)	5	2
3. \$100/mo. (\$1,200/yr.)	8	11
4. \$50/mo. (\$600/yr.)	15	14
5. \$25/mo. (\$300/yr.)	20	19
6. Less than \$300/yr.	—	11
